Welcome Athletes, Coaches and Parents,

Big White is welcoming you to the first ever IFSA Junior Freeski event from the 16th - 18th of February in the Falcon Bowl.

As an update, with a base of 240 cms here at Big White, the Falcon Bowl is in amazing condition to host this event. With more snow on the way, the stoke is high! Enjoy the mountain, the conditions, the events, and venue.

In this welcome package you will find the registration information, lift pass information, event schedule, venue details, and athlete bio form for you to fill out in advance.

Registration Information

Registration will be located in the conference room of the White Crystal Inn which is located in the village next to the gondola.

Athletes will be required to fill out and sign the Big White waiver and also the athlete Bio.

The bibs will be handed out during registration after paying a 20\$ deposit for each bib.

Athlete, coach, and parent vouchers for lift tickets will be handed out during the registration process.

Lift Tickets

Athletes will receive a 50% discount for the three day event and vouchers will be issued during registration.

Coaches will receive vouchers for free lift passes for every 5 athletes they are coaching. In the event there are less than 5 athletes the coach will receive a 50% discount. Coaches must submit their request no later than the 13th of February along with their IFSA coaches number and the names of the athletes they are coaching.

Both parents are eligible for a 25% discount on lift tickets if the competing athlete is part of a ski team. Parents must submit their names, athlete names, and name of associated ski team no later than the 13th of February qualify for this discount.

Venue Information

The venue is located in the Falcon Bowl under the Falcon Chair.

Access to the venue can be from the Ridge Chair, Snow Ghost, or Bullet Chair then to the T-bar. From the top of the T-bar take Whitefoot trail through the powder bowl into the Falcon Chair. These trails are well marked.

Alternately, you can take the Gem Lake Express Chair then take either Playground or Village Way runs to the Falcon Chair.

The inspection is planned for Friday afternoon and it is MANDATORY that the athletes wear their bibs. If athletes do not have their bibs they will not be allowed in the venue.

Athletes must also wear their bibs to gain early access on chairs and preferred access to lifts.
